Christmas Lunch

Christmas lunch for everyone will be served on Wednesday 18 December. However, in order that Jon and his team can be certain that there are enough sprouts to go around, children need to pre-order their meal by this Friday, 6 December. In each class, there will be a sign up sheet where the children choose either Christmas dinner, Veggie Christmas Dinner or Packed lunch from home. There are no sandwich or jacket potato options on this day. (Any children with specific dietary needs that are currently identified to the catering team will be cooked for in the usual way). There is no change to school meal payments for Christmas Lunch, you simply need to ensure that there are sufficient funds in your child's ParentPay account (Foundation and KS1 children are all entitled to a free meal under the Universal Free School Meals scheme).

The post box is now located in the school reception. Please make sure that any Christmas Cards you are sending clearly state the full name of the child and the class they are in so that they can all be delivered to the correct recipients.
