Face Masks

In this world of ever-changing guidance and advice we have recently been sent this by the Local Authority:

*'Whilst Sheffield is not identified as an area of high virus transmission and is not identified as an area of Government intervention at this time the Sheffield Director of Public Health advises all pupils, students and staff in secondary schools, FE colleges and Universities that face coverings **should be worn** in communal areas and on corridors. In primary schools where social distancing is not possible (in areas outside of classrooms between members of staff or visitors, for example in staffrooms) wearing face coverings in these circumstances is advised. **It will not be necessary to wear face coverings in classrooms.**'*

As a consequence, I have instructed all staff to follow this revised guidance about the wearing of face masks in communal areas. Should parents wish to wear face masks whilst on the site, that remains your decision.

I will, next week, send out a diary dates sheet however, it will be brief. At the moment, I will not be including dates for our traditional performances or the other range of events we get involved in. If the guidance changes, we will let you know. Parent consultations will be included however, at the moment, these will be undertaken via Zoom. Again, all of this will be subject to revised guidance. Currently, the clear message we are being given is to restrict contact - particularly with non-school based adults.



Staff will continue to work with and support the children. The teachers are looking forward to the swap morning which will set the tone for the work due to begin on Monday. It will be a great opportunity for the children to meet their new teacher and work in their new rooms.
